Did you know there is an Extended Day Kindergarten program located in each elementary school in Merrimack?

The Merrimack School District has partnered with the Nashua Adult Learning Center to offer a mid-day program for kindergarten students. The program is designed for children attending the morning kindergarten session who are looking for more socializing time or who are in need of care when school is dismissed at 11:00 AM.

What We Offer

Developmentally appropriate indoor and outdoor activities and games, cooperative play and enrichment.

- Parents can pick up their children at 2:45 PM or children may take the school bus home.
- Children can attend the Extended Day program as little as once a week or all five days.
- The program is on-site at each elementary school.

What Makes Us Special

Our Extended Day Kindergarten Program is a place where your children will be safe, happy, and will have lots of fun.

You can sign up for as little as 1 day or as many as 5 days. The Extended Day Kindergarten Program operates on the same schedule as the school district. The session begins at dismissal (11:00 AM) from the morning kindergarten program and ends at the regular school day (2:45 PM). There is time for lunch (provided by you) and a snack later in the day (provided by us).

Parents can pick up their children at 2:45 PM or they may take the school bus home. We also offer after school care from the end of the school day until 6:00 PM. Pick up after school is by parents any time during our hours of operation.

The Nashua Adult Learning Center's School Age Adventures program is licensed through the State of New Hampshire. Qualified staff members are in charge of each program and we maintain a staff to child ratio in each program that exceeds licensing standards.
